## Directions

### Frances S DeMasi Middle School 199 Evesboro-Medford Road (Route 168), Marlton, NJ 08053

**By Automobile, From NYC and Northern New Jersey via NJTP:** Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit #4 for Mount Laurel, NJ. Stay on the left side out of the toll booth and follow signs for Route 73 South towards Atlantic City. Once on Route 73 South, move into the 2nd left lane and make a light left turn at second traffic light and follow signs for Church Road East. Drive on Church Road E for about 1.5 miles, cross intersection with Church *Street* (Please note that Church Road and Church Street intersect here) and continue on Church Road for 0.2 miles. Cross Greentree Road at next traffic light and *continue straight* on Evesboro-Medford Road (*Do not make any turns*). Drive on Evesboro-Medford Road (Route 618) for about 0.9 miles. Frances S DeMasi School will be on your right side. Please park at the back or the front of the school. Please note that the entrance *Door D* on the left side of the school (see sign for Gymnasium) will be the only entrance that will be open.

**By Automobile, From North New Jersey via I-295:** Take I-295 South to exit #36A for Berlin. Take Route 73 South for about 1 and 1/2 mile. Please stay in the left lane and make a slight left turn at the 3<sup>rd</sup> traffic light and follow signs for Church Road East. Drive on Church Road E for about 1.5 miles, cross intersection with Church *Street* (Please note that Church Road and Church Street intersect here) and continue on Church Road for 0.2 miles. Cross Greentree Road at next traffic light and *continue straight* on Evesboro-Medford Road (*Do not make any turns*). Drive on Evesboro-Medford Road (Route 618) for about 0.9 miles. Frances S DeMasi School will be on your right side. Please park at the back or the front of the school. Please note that the entrance *Door D* on the left side of the school (see sign for Gymnasium) will be the only entrance that will be open.

**By Automobile, From DE, MD or VA via I-295:** From I-95 North, follow Delaware Memorial Bridge to I-295 North. In NJ take exit #34A for Marlton. Take Route 70 East for 1/2 mile. Make a right turn at 1st light on Marlcross Road. Move to the left lane, make a left turn and follow signs for Greentree Road. Please note that Greentree Road starts here. Cross Route 70 and continue driving on Greentree road for about 3 miles, cross about 7 traffic lights and make a right turn at the next traffic light on Evesboro-Medford Road (after TD Bank North). Drive on Evesboro-Medford Road (Route 618) for about 0.9 miles. Frances S DeMasi School will be on your right side. Please park at the back or the front of the school. Please note that the entrance *Door D* on the left side of the school (see sign for Gymnasium) will be the only entrance that will be open.

**By Automobile, From PA via PA turnpike:** From PA turnpike take exit 24, follow I-76E towards Walt Whitman Bridge (NJ). After the bridge follow I-295N to exit 34A and follow directions as shown above for DE, MD or VA.

*Please do not call the school for directions but do call designated Sai Volunteers for directions.*

**By Public Transportation:** Greyhound buses from NYC – depart from Port Authority and stop at Mt. Laurel NJ. A bus from NY City leaves at 10:55 AM and arrives in Mount Laurel, NJ at 12:35 PM.
